MORNING ARRIVALS- Students are not to arrive on campus before 7:15 a.m. If the duty teacher is not present, please wait for them to arrive before allowing your child to exit the vehicle. Upon arrival, students in PreK and K will report directly to their classrooms. Students in Grades 1-6 will report to their respective gym area, and students in Grades 7-8 will report to the middle school walkway. Teachers will be strategically placed around campus to assist students.

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**ASSEMBLY** - We are thrilled to have assembly in the Old Gym each morning at 7:45. Below is a schedule. You are welcome to join us in prayer! Drop your children in their correct carpool line and then park in "C" lot (the third entrance on Stuart from Perkins Rd- crepe myrtle alley) if you plan to join us for assembly. For their safety, children should never walk through the parking lot.

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**HANDBOOK ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM** - The Parent-Student Handbook Agreement Form will be sent home with your child on the first day of school. This form must be completed for each child and returned to the homeroom teacher by August 12, 2022.

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<u>WATER BOTTLES</u> - During covid, all students had to supply their own water bottle due to the water fountains being closed. <u>All water fountains are open</u>, so it is not necessary to send one. If you choose to send one with your child, they need to be labeled with the child's FULL NAME! If it is left and not labeled, it will be thrown away.

**CAFETERIA** - A reminder that the Breakfast Snack and Lunch are no longer funded. PK & K will still have an afternoon snack provided, which is funded through their tuition. SAS is returning to a "nut aware" campus and not "nut free", which means students may NOT bring nut products for a snack but they can for lunch. These students will sit in a specific area in the cafeteria so as to not affect children with nut allergies.

**STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES** - Terra Nova Next scores from the spring 2022 testing will be sent home with students in grades 4-8 on their first day of school. Please read the information enclosed with the scores for specifics about testing and scores.

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**GOOGLE/EMAIL FYI**- Gmail is turned OFF for grades PreK-4. We only use their "email" address to log into Google Classroom. Therefore, if you try to sign into gmail, you will get an error message. If you go to <u>classroom.google.com</u> instead, you will be able to log in to Google Classroom with your child's email address.

**SCHOOL COMMUNICATION** - The handbook states that "During the work week, teachers will respond to phone messages or email within 24 hours of receiving the message. Additionally, if you send an email on a Friday, the message will be returned by the next work day which is Monday. Teachers are not required to respond on their weekend, as that is their family time and that needs to be honored and respected.
