CARPOOL REMINDERS:

In an effort to keep the carpool lines safe and effective, please abide by all posted signs. As a general reminder:

- Please do not enter the carpool line from Orchid Street. There is a 'No Left Turn' sign posted. For lots A, B, and C, to enter the main carpool line on Stuart Avenue from a side street, please enter from Tupello Street or Poplar Street.
- Please do not make a U-turn at Orchid Street
- When exiting Carpool Lot D (church office lot) please do not turn left into the main carpool line.

<u>CAMPUS VISITORS</u>: All visitors to SAS during the school day must check in at the front office and receive a visitor's pass to wear while on campus. 
